What is the Hope Project?

For anyone unfamiliar with the Hope Project media efforts - here is the summary.

- The Hope Project is a multimedia Christian communications effort coordinated by the Shining Lights Trust.
- Three annual media projects are envisaged to represent Christian messages in the public square - only two which currently happen: Hope Project Easter and Hope Project Christmas
 - 2020 is the 6th run of the Hope Project Easter, with a range of fresh media (including the booklets) each time.
 - Hope Project Christmas is about uniting churches nationally to return nativity scenes to Christmas.
 - Hope Project Easter is a larger project. Its three goals are
 - I. To put Christ back into Easter through public media
 - II. To re-educate many on the Christian dynamics behind our bicultural history and values history (where our values came from)
 - III. To 'seed' the nation annually with the Christian message of hope in a gentle, respectful and clear-thinking way
