IMPORTANT NOTICE: The Ca-

rew Church congregation have met and agreed to ask Parish Council to put in process the sale of their church for removal and the gifting of the land to the Carew Hall Committee for a reserve. Under the Book of Order we are required to consult with the congregations throughout the whole Parish and therefore wish to call congregational meetings to discuss our recommendation. Dates for these congregational meetings will be 26th June at the end of the church services at Rakaia, Mayfield and Methven.

The motion will be:

"That Plains Presbyterian Parish apply to Alpine Presbytery and Church Property Trustees to sell the Carew church building for removal and such chattels as have not been gifted back to the families who have donated them.

"That Plains Presbyterian apply to Alpine Presbytery and Church Property Trustees to gift the land at the Carew Church to the Carew Hall Committee to become a memorial reserve."
