GOVERNANCE COUNCIL REPORT - 27TH SEPTEMBER MEETING

The following discussion points arose at our monthly meeting with outcomes important to share around the parish as a whole.

Rev Henry Mbambo from St David's Union Church in Ashburton has written to ask if Plains would be interested in joining the other Mid Canterbury Churches for a combined Carol Service. We have replied 'yes' and also offered as a possible host at St. John's.

As a follow-up from the Mid Canterbury Hui on 6th July, we have written to the five other churches in Mid Canterbury suggesting we set up a steering committee of two representatives from each church to begin looking at ways we can work together. To date Hakatere Parish are in – and we are hoping for more responses once their governance groups meet.

Governance Members are distributing Plains Draft Financial Policy to the individual mission/focus groups for feedback. Our parish hasn't had such a policy and with the changeover of treasurer, we realise the importance of having systems in place whereby historical knowledge is passed on.

- As at the writing of this report, we have met our budget line for fundraising this year, plus some. Thanks to the wonderful effort of Rakaia church at their recent annual Plant Fair as well as catering they undertook recently. A wonderful community event that brings in people from all over Canterbury – attended by gardeners and non-gardeners alike, all of which know a bargain when they see one!

We have applied and received money from the Mayfield Stock Trust – again the effort by individuals to raise funds on our behalf is really appreciated.
