GOVERNANCE REPORT:

Parish Council met Tuesday 31 May with a very full agenda. We received from RangzenPro the new Detailed Seismic Assessment (DSA) reports for all our properties. While there is much in the report to be positive about, it has highlighted some challenges ahead for us in ensuring our buildings meet the PCANZ New Building Standard of 67%. To this end, we need to have a 'plan' in place by June 2024.

Staveley Church has been given a rating of 70% - not uncommon for wooden buildings. Methven Church and Mayfield Hall and adjoining rooms meet requirements while Mayfield Church, Methven Hall, Rakaia Church and Hall all need strengthening repairs to bring them up to the required standard. For strengthening work to be undertaken, Building Consents from Ashburton Council will be required, and this means also meeting current accessibility and fire regulations.

The report is very comprehensive and has been shared with Parish Council members as well as made available to members of the Property, Worship and Finance subcommittees. With support from Alpine Presbytery, we will be working through the report in the next 4 - 5 weeks and developing a plan to plot our approach in meeting these challenges.

While churches are more than our buildings – how we connect with each other, our community and God is our mission – we need to take responsibility for ensuring our buildings are safe, well maintained and meet PCANZ requirements. We will keep the parish informed of progress through the Bulletin (which is also on our website).

CAREW CHURCH SERVICE

Plains Presbyterian invite all interested to attend a service on Sunday 11th June, at 2pm, to decommission the Carew Presbyterian Church.

The worship will be followed by afternoon tea in the Carew Hall.
