The Pruner. There are fields and fields of sunflowers bright and gleaming in the sunlight. They fill the air with an indefinable perfume and the busy humming of the bees. Some of the "younger" flowers hold their heads up high, soaking in the sun. The "older" ones grown heavy and ripe with age, bow down, their faces filled with seeds that

will be crushed and broken into oil. Like people crowded together on the terraces at a football match, they sway and turn to get the last of the sunlight. Grapevines too hug the vines, some well pruned, gnarled and twisted, bearing the promise of a good grape harvest. Young vines tenderly trained along the wires and touch hands with neighbours. Some vineyards are choked with weeds, the branches growing long and straggly with clusters of grapes. The plants look neglected. This reminds us of our own spiritual lives. Difficulties and setbacks serve as pruning shears cutting away all our wants but providing our needs.
